
Select A Course for Licensure

- Go To: http://e.get-licensed.co.uk/
- Select Course for Licensure

Courses that may be selected are listed on the home page. For full search results go to the right side of the screen, locate the Courses tab and click the small arrow4. A longer list of courses will drop down and the All Courses... option at the bottom will grant you access to additional course categories.

Once you select a course, you will be prompted to:


- > Login

- ➤ **Verify** that you wish to enrol yourself as a member of the course when prompted to do so.




<u>For Future Reference</u>: Once an account is created, use the login area at the top right hand side of the screen.

- Logout




Access Course Information

- Select course from the list of courses enrolled in [Level 2 Award in Door Supervision (QCF)]




Selecting the course will direct you to a topic outline where you can access all related information

Use the arrows at the bottom of the screen to scroll through the slides.




Moves Forward through slides




