

How-To Use the E-Learning Portal for **GET LICENSED** *

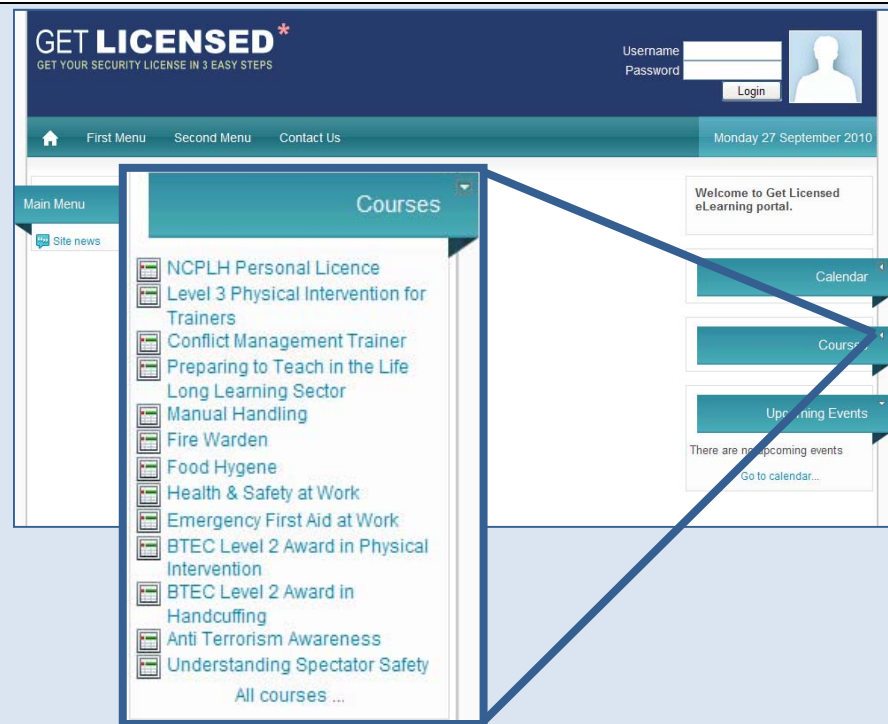
Select A Course for Licensure

- Go To: <http://e.get-licensed.co.uk/>
- Select Course for Licensure

Courses that may be selected are listed on the home page. For full search results go to the right side of the screen, locate the **Courses** tab and click the small arrow. A longer list of courses will drop down and the **All Courses...** option at the bottom will grant you access to additional course categories.

Once you select a course, you will be prompted to:

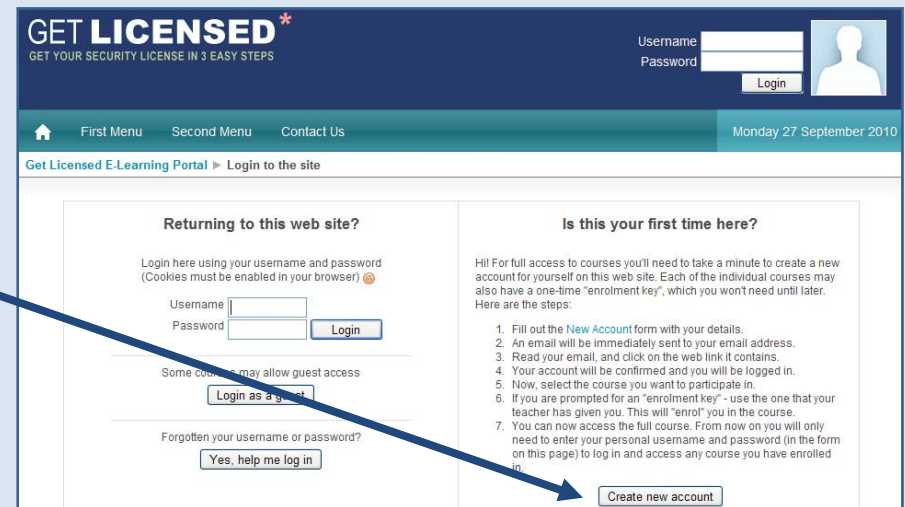
- Login
- Create New Account



Create an Account and Login

New Users:

- Select
- Create a **Username** and **Password** and fill out the requested information.
 - Remember to keep this in a safe and accessible place because you will use the information to sign in.
- **Confirm your account** by going to the web address (click the link) provided to you via email.
- **Verify** that you wish to enrol yourself as a member of the course when prompted to do so.

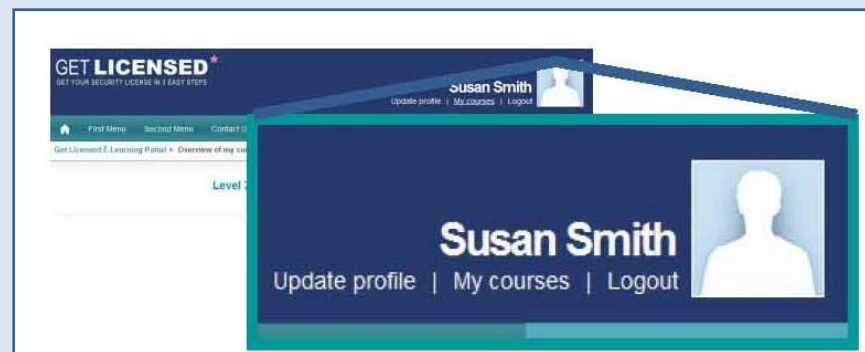


For Future Reference: Once an account is created, use the login area at the top right hand side of the screen.

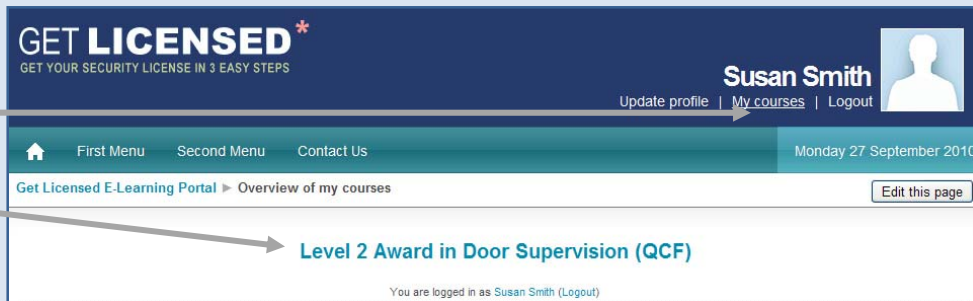
After successfully registering and logging in, the upper right corner of the screen will display your name (ie. Susan Smith) and provide links to:

- **Logout**



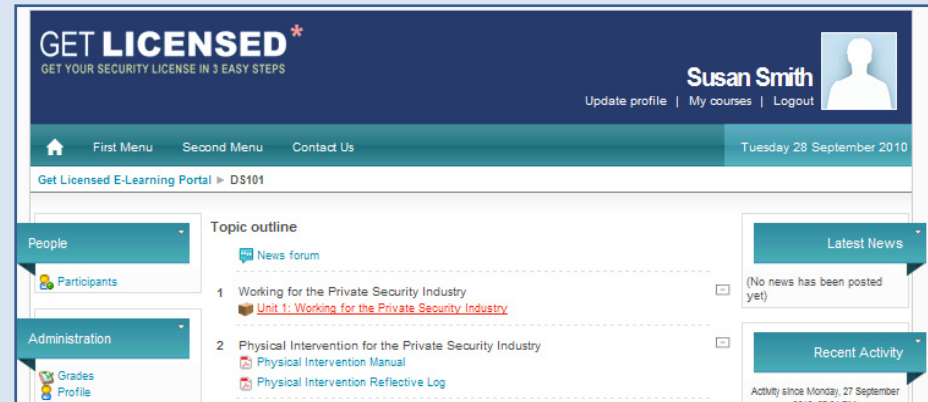
Access Course Information

Use the arrows at the bottom of the screen to scroll through the slides.

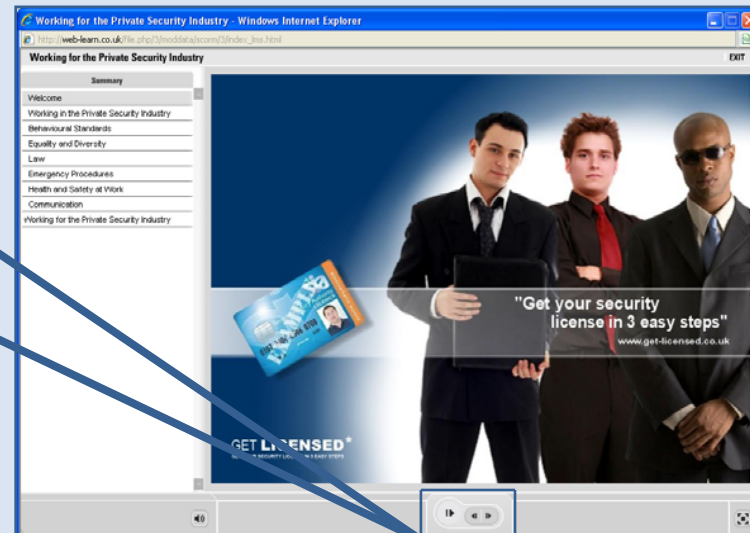


Moves **Forward** through slides

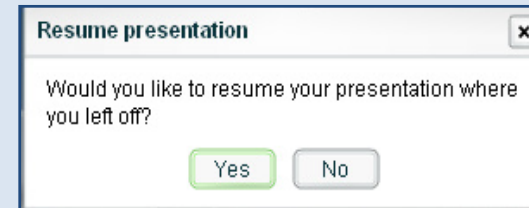


Moves **Backward** through slides

Taking Quizzes

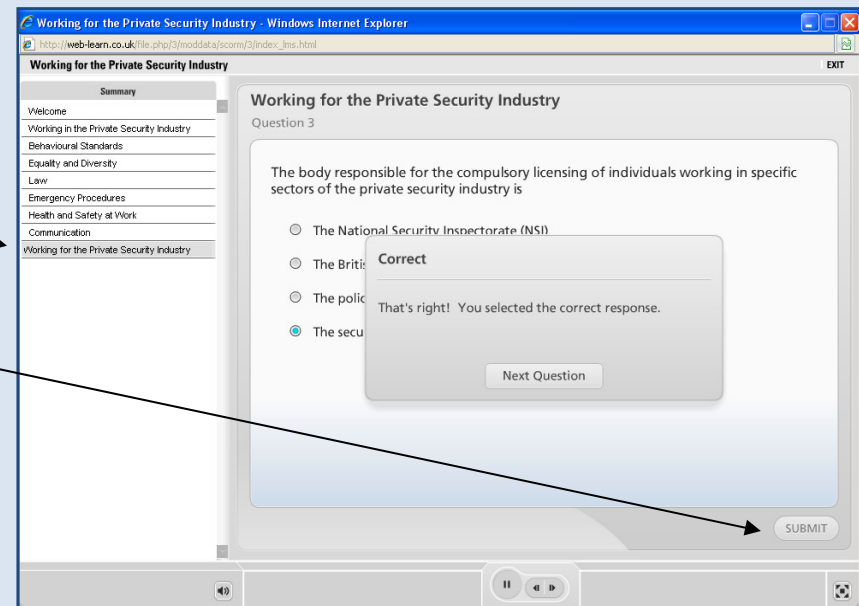
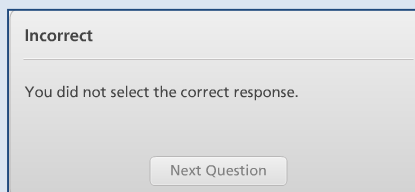
After watching all of the slides for each section of the unit, there is a quiz at the end.

If the answer is incorrect, this image will pop up.



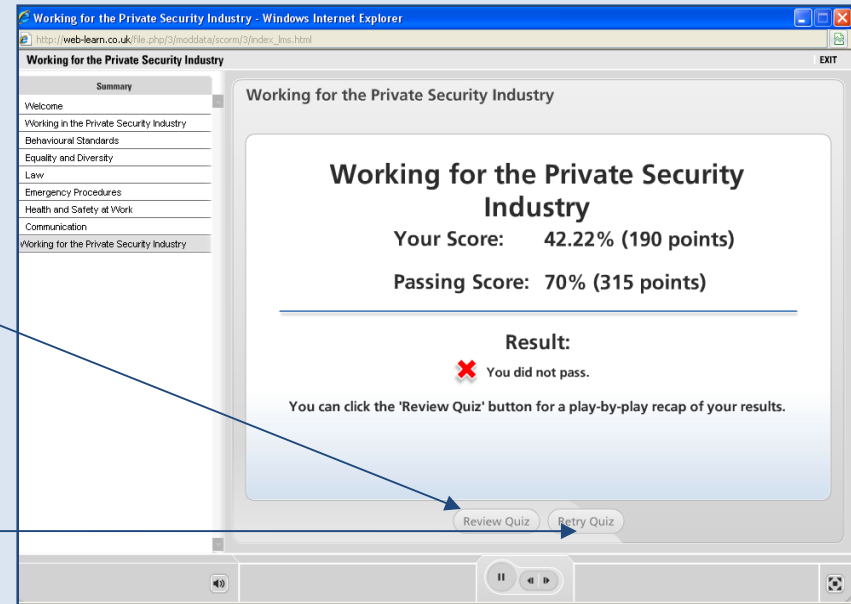
When the quiz is complete, your final score is displayed. A 70% is required to pass. If you scored below a 70% or got a few answers incorrect, click
